

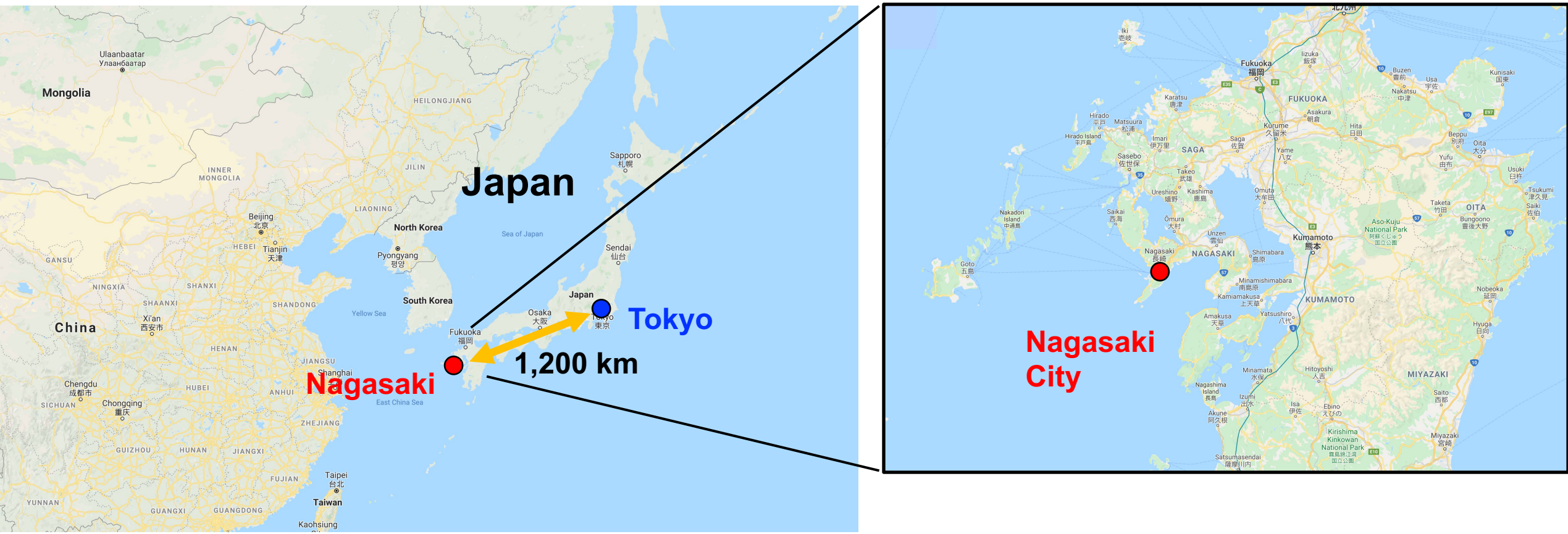

# Where is Nagasaki?

- Southwest of Japan, one of the **first opened ports in Japan about 450 years ago (1571)**
- Historically, plays an important role in international relations in Japan
- Surrounded by natural beauty on all sides; sea, mountains & many islands



## Easy access to Nagasaki

- From Europe/USA and many countries, first fly to Tokyo, Osaka or Nagoya
  - Tokyo (Haneda) → Nagasaki : 14 /day (2 hours)
  - Tokyo (Narita) → Nagasaki: 2 /day (2 hours)
  - Osaka (KIX) → Nagasaki: 2 /day (70 min)
  - Nagoya (Chubu) → Nagasaki: 1 /day (75 min)
  - Shanghai → Nagasaki: 1 /day

→ Then use airport shuttle bus to the venue directly (45 min)

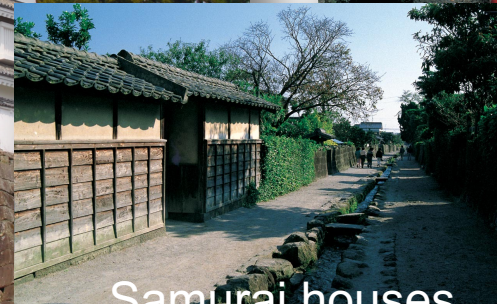

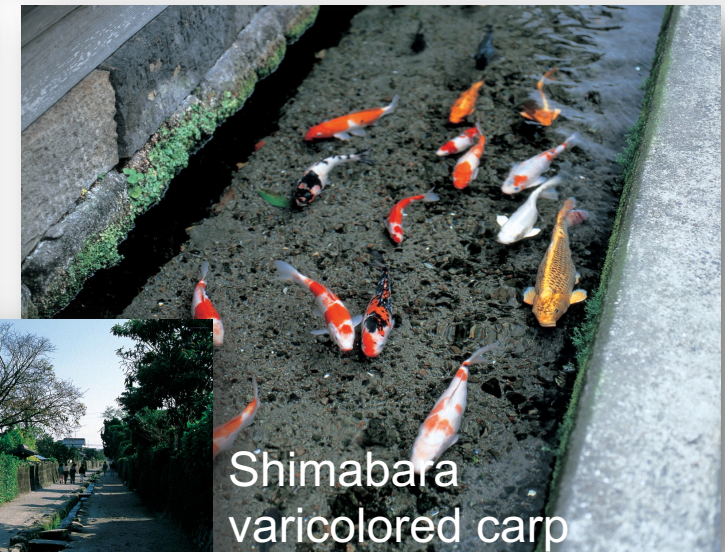

# “Dejima”: only place to open for foreign countries 8

- Period of national isolation in Japan, “Sakoku” (1639 – 1854), **for about 215 years**
- “Dejima” : only place in all of Japan which was open for communication with visitors from Europe and the wider world.

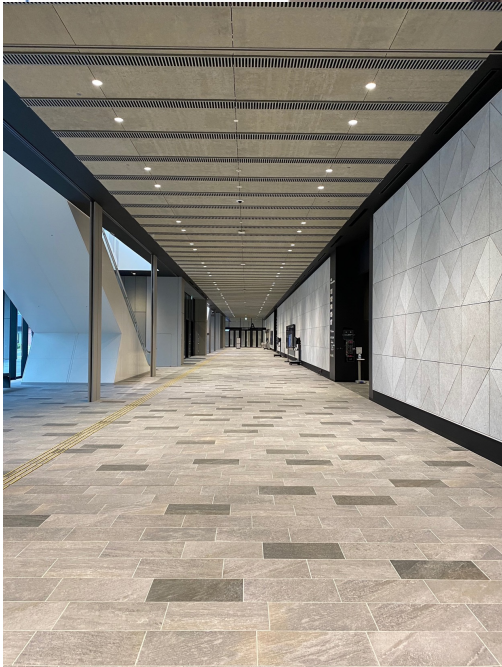
