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Please note that not all of these tools are free or GDPR compliant, and there may be other factors to consider. This list was compiled based on our research and word of mouth. We are not directly recommending any, as we have not tested all these tools ourselves. We strongly suggest conducting further research before using them.

<u>ChatGPT</u> is a large language model chatbot that can have conversations with you, generate different creative text formats, translate languages, and answer your questions in an informative way.



<u>ClickUp</u> is a project management tool that helps you organize tasks, collaborate with others, and track progress.



<u>Connected Papers</u> is an Al-powered research visual tool that helps you discover relevant academic papers based on your interests.



<u>Copilot</u> is Microsoft's large language model chatbot that can have conversations with you, generate different creative text formats, translate languages, and answer your questions in an informative way. Some universities have partnerships with Microsoft so students and staff can use CoPilot safely without their data being used for training the AI model; simply log in with your university email.



<u>Deepl</u> is a machine translation tool known for its high accuracy and ability to translate languages naturally.



<u>Elicit</u> is an AI tool designed to assist with searching for research papers. By posing a research question, you can receive a curated list of relevant papers. Elicit also helps summarise these papers, extract key answers and automates systematic reviews.



**Fireflies.ai** uses AI to help you transcribe, summarize, search, and analyze voice conversations with others, automating meeting notes.



**Gamma** is an Al-powered tool to create and edit presentations, websites and documents.



<u>Gemini</u> is Google's large language model chatbot that can have conversations with you, generate different creative text formats, translate languages, and answer your questions in an informative way.



goblin.tools is a collection of small, simple, single-task tools, designed to help neurodivergent people with tasks they find overwhelming or difficult. The tools are Magic ToDo, Formalizer, Judge, Professor, Estimator, Compiler and Chef.



<u>Grammarly</u> is a grammar checker and writing assistant that helps you improve the clarity, accuracy, and style of your writing.

## Hemingway

<u>Hemingway Editor</u> is a writing style checker that helps you write clear and concise prose by highlighting complex sentences, passive voice, and adverbs.



<u>Jasper</u> is an AI marketing and writing assistant that can help you generate different creative text formats like blog posts and social media content.

## **L** Litmaps

<u>Litmaps</u> uses the citation network to provide a bird's eye view of connected papers. It helps you discover literature that's easily overlooked with other search methods.



<u>Motion</u> is an AI calendar assistant that helps with project management, task prioritisation, and deadline tracking.



<u>Notion</u> is a project management and note-taking app that lets you organize your work, ideas and information in a flexible way. Notion AI is its AI assistant designed to help with writing, data management, and streamlining workflows.



Otter.ai produces transcripts, automated summaries, and action items, and allows you to chat with Otter to get answers from your meetings, making it easier to capture and revisit important information from meetings or lectures.



<u>Perplexity</u> is a free AI search engine, designed as a research partner. Ask any question, and it searches the internet to give you an accessible, conversational, and verifiable answer.



<u>ProWritingAid</u> is grammar checker, style editor, and plagiarism checker that helps you improve the quality of your writing.



<u>QuillBot</u> has an Edge extension and helps as a paraphraser, grammar checker, plagiarism checker, Al detector, summarizer, citation generator, translator and flow checker.



**ResearchRabbit** is a search engine of academic papers that helps explore and find visually how papers might be connected. Helps with creating a library and recommendation of relevant papers.



<u>Scholarcy</u> is an AI-powered research tool that helps you discover relevant academic articles and track research trends in your field.



<u>Scite</u> is a tool which analyses scientific citations to determine if they support or contradict the cited research, to allow for quick assessment of the credibility and impact of scientific papers.



<u>Slick Write</u> is a free application that makes it easy to check your writing for grammar errors, potential stylistic mistakes, and other features of interest.



**Zoom Al Companion** is a real-time translation and transcription Al companion tool that works within Zoom meetings, making communication easier for participants who speak different languages.
