FYI Münster

Public Transport:

- Our stop: Aegidiimarkt/LWL-Museum
- Bus lines that go there from main station (Hauptbahnhof): 2, 4, 10, 11, 12, 14, 22
- The 'Stadtwerke Münster' are responsible for public transport in town, it might make sense to download the app for the duration of your stay: (iOS; Android)
- 'tretty': a good way to get around Münster is by bike, the bike lanes are practically everywhere and with the 'tretty' app they are easy to find and rent (<u>iOS</u>; <u>Android</u>)
- E-scooters: are available from 'Tier', 'Bolt' and 'Voi'
- Taxi: cabs will sometimes be available outside the main station, otherwise you can easily get the "taxi.eu" app to order one. (iOS android: Android)
- Free Now is a mobility app that combines multiple ways of getting around and you can use it to quickly book a ride online (scan the QR code on this page to download the app: https://www.free-now.com/de/fahrt/app-herunterladen/)

Things To Do and See:

- **Prinzipalmarkt/Rathaus**: The heart of Mpnster's old town, and very close to the conference location. Find more information here
- **Lambertikirche**: If you're already at Prinzipalmarkt, your cannot skip <u>Lamberti</u>, a beautiful gothic church with a gruesome history.
- **Antiquariat Solder**: Frauenstraße 49/50 → old books, but also prominently featured on German crime show *Wilsberg*
- **Homebeis**: Aegidiistraße 2-3 → small store with local goods
- Rosta Bookstore: Aegidiistraße 12 → our favorite independet book store
- Aasee → great to take a walk, but NO swimming, not even a little bit.
- Schloss/Botanical garden: Schlossplatz $2 \rightarrow$ garden is behind the Schloss
- **LWL Museum for Art**: Domplatz 10
- **Dom/Markt**: Domplatz → if you are staying past the duration of the conference, the market on Saturday is a must. Here you can find a variety of fun and local foods (try Leckermädel cheesecake!), flowers and other things from the area. Because as we say in Münster, Samstag ist Markttag!

Food:

- ChayChay: Frauenstraße 51 → Asian fusion and delicious vietnamese coffee
- **Fischbrathalle**: Schlaunstraße 8
- **Kiepenkerl**: Spiekerhof $45 \rightarrow$ for authentic Westfalian meals
- Lux: Domplatz 10 → inside the LWL art museum, try the Mint Julep!

- Café SpecOps: Aegidiimarkt $5 \rightarrow$ cash only


- **Roestbar**: Rotheburg 17

- Fyal Central: Geisbergweg 8

How-To: from main station to the conference:

English Seminar: Johannisstraße 12-20, 48143 Münster

When you arrive at the main station, take the exist to Berliner Platz/ City Centre. From there you can either get a bus, or any of the means of transportation mentioned above really. However, we recommend going by foot if its possible. If you take the route using Windthorststraße (here in blue) you will not only walk past a stretch of the promenade, but it will also lead through a part of downtown Münster, so you will already get to see the city!



As you can see above we are right in the city centre, so everything important can be reached by foot within a radius of 15-20 minutes.

About the bikes: when walking on the sidewalk, make sure to only walk on the grey part, the red one is for the bikes and they WILL be mad at you if you're in the way. Also, when renting a bike and cycling through the city, make sure to stay in the right side of the road or when driving on the sidewalk. The bike cops are viscious and practically everywhere.
