

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES/REGULATIONS LMET Conference

(As of 28 September 2021 and until further notice)

1) NEGATIVE CORONA TESTS REQUIRED

Due to the number of international guests and for the safety and protection of **all** conference participants and conference organizing team members, we are requesting that **everyone be tested on Monday, October 4**th <u>and</u> **Tuesday, October 5**th, regardless of your immunization/recovery status. **Self-tests will not be accepted**.

For this purpose and for your convenience, we have arranged for the Johanniter to perform the tests on Monday, October 4^{th} , between 8 am and 11 am, in the Senatssaal of the castle (venue 1), as well as on Tuesday, October 5^{th} , between 8 am and 10 am, in room 40 of the Fürstenberghaus (venue 2).

Should you not be able to make the time slots mentioned above, you are responsible for getting tested elsewhere. There are two locations in the downtown area where rapid testing is available to everyone, **free of charge**:

*Please note: Proof of a negative test result is obligatory to be admitted to the conference. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding!

2) MANDATORY MASK REQUIREMENT / MINIMUM DISTANCING

Medical face masks must be worn inside WWU buildings whenever minimum distancing cannot be observed. As a rule, a minimum distance of 1.5 meters from others must be maintained at all times. For conference purposes, this refers particularly to the break times. The lecture halls are large enough to ensure a minimum of 1.5-meter distance between participants, so that the masks may be removed once you have taken your seat. However, when congregating, particularly in the foyers of the venues, you must wear your mask at all times, except while eating or drinking.

3) FURTHER PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

The conference organizers will take care that the lecture halls receive enough fresh air between talks and that hand sanitizers are readily available. Entry to university buildings is forbidden to anyone who suffers from typical symptoms of Covid-19 which cannot be attributed to other causes.
